The Pastor's Pen



I once read a book by John C. Maxwell, a motivational speaker for Christian leadership, called *Failing Forward*. Throughout his book, he emphasizes the need for everyone to understand we experience failures. We experience them, but they do not have to set us back for too long. They may help carry us forward. In one of his chapters, Maxwell outlines many obstacles that hinder us from moving forward and living life. One of those is regret. He illustrates this point by a story he received from a friend via email:

"I booked my reservation on Wish I Had airlines. I didn't check my bags - everyone carries their baggage on this airplane - and had to drag it for what seemed like miles in the Regret City airport. And I could see that people from all over the world were there with me, limping along under the weight of bags they had packed themselves.

"I caught a cab to Last Resort Hotel, the driver taking the whole trip backwards, looking over his shoulder. And there I found the ballroom where my event would be held: the Annual Pity Party. As I checked in, I saw all my old colleagues were on the guest list:

The Done family – Woulda, Coulda, and Shoulda Both of the Opportunities – Missed and Lost

All the Yesterdays – there were too many to count, but all would have sad stories to share.

"Shattered Dreams and Broken Dreams would be there, too, along with their friends Don't Blame Me and Couldn't Help It. And, of course, hours and hours of entertainment would be provided by the renowned storyteller It's Their Fault.

"As I prepared to settle in for a REALLY long night, I realized that one person had the power to send all those people home and break up the party: me. All I had to do was return to the present and welcome the new day!"

We are reminded of the words from Psalm 40: "I waited patiently for the LORD; he turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD. Blessed is the man who makes the LORD his trust, who does not look to the proud, to those who turn aside to false gods" (vss.

John Maxwell suggests that, when we fail, we acknowledge the pain and grieve the loss (lost time, lost opportunity to succeed, lost courage, etc.) But then we forgive the moment, forgive anybody involved, and forgive ourselves. We release the moment and move on with God. As we face great and small troubles, it is easy to focus on the pain rather than on God and His salvation. Life is not to be lived regretting our failures. God picks us up from the ground, brushes the dust from our clothes, and sends us on our way again. We are smarter than before. We are more blessed than before. We have great things still to do for God and His kingdom.
