The Pastor's Pen



AT&T is very worried about me. Or, at least the company appears to be.

I keep getting these emails from AT&T in regards to my email account. "This is for your own safety," they tell me, "to avoid the closure of your AT&T mail. You will have to verify your account by filling out your Log-In information below by clicking the Reply button." They are very worried about me because they don't want me to lose my account for any reason.

Now, my email account for the church is an AT&T account, and I use it *quite frequently*. It isn't as though I check my email once every two months. I check it more than once or twice a day on most days. I could see if I only opened my email on every blue moon, there could be, might be, the possibility of losing my account. But then, email providers do not cancel people's account due to infrequent use. At least this has been my experience in the past. I think my wife still has a certain email account that she hasn't used in over a decade.

AT&T – or the dudes who are posing as AT&T – seems to be very worried about me. Their emails are obviously spam-related and fraudulent. If I click to reply, I must give my User ID, my Current Password, my Occupation, my Birth Date, and my Country of Residence. That is a huge red flag! Doesn't the true AT&T have this information about me already? They want to make sure I have the information, I guess. Well, I know full well that if I only give my user ID and current password, I will become another victim of identify fraud. So I always send these emails to Spam or just delete them.

I will say this about the spammers out there: they are persistent. They appear to be concerned about us, and they are persistent in sharing that concern. Makes me think of how God loves us, and how persistent God is in loving us. God's love is true – there is nothing fake about it or in it. Throughout the Bible we read stories of how God constantly revealed his love to his people, enduring their hardships with them, bearing their unfaithfulness toward him, opening the path of life to them.

"The earth is full of the lovingkindness of the LORD," Psalm 33:5 says. "In your unending love you will lead the people you have redeemed. In your strength you will guide them to your holy dwelling... But I trust in your unending love; my heart rejoices in your salvation... [Nothing] in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Exodus 15:13, Psalm 13:5, Romans 8:39). This is genuine, honest-to-goodness, from the tips of your toes to the top of your head, down to the very core love that God expresses for us. It never diminishes. It is never conditional. It will always flow.

When we don't love ourselves, God is persistent in revealing that we are special and worth loving. When we don't love others, God is persistent in filling our hearts with love, so we may sympathize and work alongside others.

There are crooks out there who try to grab our attention, so they might steal something from us. God is out there and in here, trying to grab our attention to give us something. His love. Whether it comes in email form or through a warm sense of joy, we willingly open it and respond.

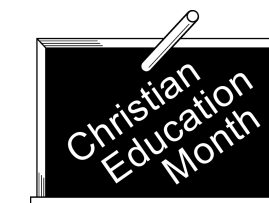
